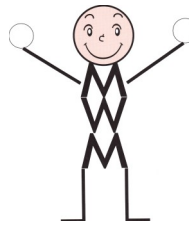
Sunday Brunch

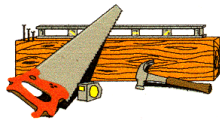
